Meaning of Community:

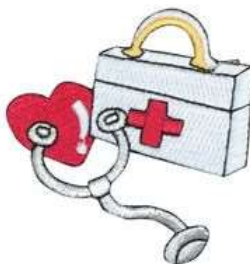
a feeling of fellowship with others, as a result of sharing common attitudes, interests, and goals:
