

Lodge Plus One Incentive Offer

The Moose International Board of Directors has approved a new incentive for fiscal year 2024-25 that will rebate \$38 of dues paid to Moose International for every member over the Lodge's final active member count from fiscal year ending on April 30, 2025.

For example, if a Lodge has 100 members on that date and its active member count in April 30, 2025 is 115, the Lodge would receive a credit of \$570 which would go towards the Lodge's Moose Int'l Accounts Receivable.

By achieving a gain of 30+ members, the Lodge will receive a check at the end of this next fiscal year. There is no limit to the number of rebates the Lodge can receive. We started this year with 159 members, we got this!
